What is YAC? The 2019 CAEA Youth Art Celebration is a preK-12th grade art show of highest caliber work created by students in Connecticut. It is a non-juried art show which celebrates the joy, expression, creation and success by school aged children. A reception is scheduled for Saturday, March 9, 2019 at Central Connecticut State University, Maloney Hall - S.T. Chen Fine Arts Center. Work must be properly mounted or matted and labeled, as described in the following information pages. Up to six pieces may be submitted per teacher. **Certificates** will be emailed to all teacher participants, which can be printed at your convenience for you and your students.

How to Submit Art Work to YAC 2019

First, **you must be a CAEA member**. Public, private, museums, preschool and home school art work is welcomed. Parents of students are NOT allowed to submit their child's art work unless they are members of CAEA and at their school. If you would like to become a member or your membership has lapsed; please go to www.CAEA.net, click on the membership tab, and follow the link to membership. Then come back to YAC page to participate!

Preparing and Packaging Artwork for YAC:

CAEA members only, are allowed to submit up to six (6) pieces of artwork. Members, who teach at more than one school, may submit six (6) works from each school. There are several showcases available for 3D work but we ask that you limit your selection to 2 works. 2D work should be no larger than 24" x 36". **CAEA's 2018 Outstanding Art Educators are invited to display up to 3 of their students 3D works, which will be displayed in one of the showcases.** All canvas must be prepared for hanging (wire or suitable hanger). Label artwork on the front right lower right corner with the official CAEA exhibit label. All artwork must be lightweight and matted or mounted with a white or neutral color.

(It may be double matted or mounted with a color inside.) No frames allowed. Both halves of inventory sheet must be filled out for each school. Do not separate the halves of inventory sheet! Inventory sheet must be securely attached to the packaging. Please use transportable, sealable packages or portfolios.

Please contact your local newspapers and e-press to publicize this event and highlight your students' work. **All YAC art work will be photographed and posted on the CAEA web site minus student names.** Please check your individual school policy prior to selection and participation.
